## PAPER 3

### GENERAL COMMENTS

Generally, the candidates' standard of presentation of work was good with candidates being able to use the conventions well.

### QUESTION 1

- (a) Candidates were not able to give the functions of foundations.
- (b) Though a compulsory question, most candidates gave no response to the question.

### QUESTION 2

- (a) The question was popular with most candidates and it was well answered. The diagram of the septic tank was well labelled and correct conventions shown.
- (b) Candidates did not attempt this question showing that they did not master the concepts.

### QUESTION 3

- (a) The question was well answered by most candidates scoring very high marks. Conversions were well outlined to the components.
- (b) This question was not answered.

### QUESTION 4

Candidates produced roof structures instead of showing the eaves details. This shows that candidates failed to comprehend the question.

### QUESTION 5

- (a) The question was popular with candidates. All parts were answered fully and correctly. Conversions were used properly which was very pleasing.

- (b) A question which was dealt with very well by most candidates. The solutions were impressive. However, candidates failed to show the skill of accuracy. This led to loss of marks.
- (c) Candidates failed to answer this question, that is, the question was not attempted.
