

CALL FOR PAPERS FOR THE 37TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT IN AFRICA (AEAA)

The Association for Educational Assessment in Africa (AEAA) is an association of stakeholders in Education in Africa. The Association promotes cooperation among examining and assessment bodies in Africa. It also organises annual conference where topical issues in teaching, learning and assessment are discussed. The conference attracts attendees beyond African countries.

The 37th Annual Conference of the Association will be hosted by the West African Examinations Council (WAEC), Nigeria from 5th to 9th August 2019 in Abuja, Nigeria. The theme and sub-themes for the conference are:

- (1) Theme: Innovations in Educational Assessment
- (2) Sub-Themes:
 - (a) Assessment for and of Teaching and Learning
 - (b) ICT and Innovative Educational Assessment
 - (c) Innovative Assessment for Quality Education
 - (d) Prospects and Challenges in Computer-Based Assessment
 - (e) The Role of ICT in Curbing Examination Malpractice
 - (f) Assistive and Adaptive Technologies: Educational Assessment for Learners with Special Needs

Prospective participants are invited to present papers at the Conference on their chosen sub-themes. Abstracts of between 350 and 500 words should be submitted via aeaawaec Lagos2019@waec.org.ng or info@aeaa Lagos.com.ng and be uploaded to <https://www.aeaafrica.org> not later than 31st March 2019. Authors whose abstracts will be accepted will be notified by email not later than 12th April 2019.

Abstracts should indicate the following:

- The sub-theme that the presentation will address;
 - Title of the presentation (bold);
 - Name(s) of the author(s) and institution(s) of affiliation;
 - Contact details: email address(es) and telephone number(s).
- The text should be in MS-word format (12 points, Times New Roman).

Full papers on accepted abstracts, of not more than 4,500 words should be submitted by 31st May 2019 and the power point slides by 12th July 2019. Please note that papers submitted should be the author's original work.

Authors of accepted papers will be expected to be present at the conference to make their presentations. Papers may have the following structure: Introduction/Theoretical Framework, Purpose(s)/Objectives, Methods/Procedures, Results/Findings, Discussion, Conclusion/Recommendations/Implications and References. All the papers should strictly follow the American Psychological Association (APA) format.

Deadline for submission of full papers: 31st May 2019.

CONFERENCE FEES


Registration Fee: US\$350
